## Attending College in Academic Year 2014 - 2015? Request the Joseph Tauber Scholarship Application

The Joseph Tauber Scholarship Program provides scholarships to children of eligible 1199SEIU members who are attending accredited undergraduate programs. Eligible members are those whose employers contribute to the National Benefit Fund or the Greater New York Child Care Fund. Members must have received Wage Class I benefits for at least one year. Candidates must be high school graduates, post-secondary school students, or previous awardees enrolled full time for a minimum of 12 college credits each semester. All candidates must be younger than 23 years of age by the start of the Fall 2014 semester. Previous awardees seeking scholarship support should note that automatic award renewals are not granted; you must reapply each year for consideration.

To request an application to the Joseph Tauber Scholarship Program, complete the application request form below and submit it before **January 31, 2014**. You may only submit one application request form per child. If both parents are 1199SEIU employees, choose one parent to submit on behalf of the child. If you need additional forms, you may download them by visiting our website at www.1199SEIUBenefits.org/ccf during the application request period. **Please note that this application request form is NOT an actual application**; it is valid for the 2014-2015 award year only.

Fax your completed request form to (646) 473-6949 or mail it to the 1199SEIU Child Care Corporation, Joseph Tauber Scholarship Program, 330 West 42nd Street, 18th Floor, New York, NY 10036-6977. Once you submit the form as instructed, if eligible, you will be sent a Scholarship Application Kit in March. The Kit includes several forms that must be completed and returned per the specific instructions and by the dates indicated, in order for consideration.

Scholarship award amounts vary according to need, with a yearly minimum award of \$750. While Joseph Tauber Scholarships can support eligible students in any field of study, the 1199SEIU Next Generation RN Scholarship program provides financial and academic assistance to children of 1199SEIU members in the clinical phase of a nursing program.
