



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Print in ink or type all entries.
2. This certification is to be used if the vehicle is sold by a person other than a dealer. A dealer cannot use this form to sell a vehicle.
3. This certification must be accompanied by bills of sale showing continuity of ownership from all previous owners.

Note: This form must be accompanied by supporting documents which will not be accepted if there are any changes or alterations on them.

Form for Seller information including Name of Seller, Mailing Address, City or Post Office, County, State, Zip Code, Year of Last Registration, State of Last Registration, Plate No., Name of Last Registrant or Previous Owner, and Address of Last Registrant.

PURCHASER: Before purchase, be sure you find out if there are any liens on it. One way to do this is to contact your County Clerk's Office

Form for Purchaser information including Name of Purchaser, Mailing Address, City or Post Office, County, State, Zip Code, and Date of Purchase.

VEHICLE DESCRIPTION form with fields for Year, Make, Vehicle Identification Number, fuel type (Gas, Propane, Electric, Flex, Diesel, CNG), Body Type, Color, Maximum Performance Speed of Motorcycle, Unladen Weight, and Cylinders.

VEHICLE INSPECTION form with fields for Date of Last Inspection, Inspection Sticker Number, and Station Number.

CERTIFICATION OF SELLER section with a statement of ownership and a signature line marked with an 'X'.

CERTIFICATION OF PURCHASER section with a statement of purchase and a signature line marked with an 'X'.
