EYELASH EXTENSION – AFTER CARE

- Do not wash your eyes or shower for 24 hours. Do not do anything that would get your lashes wet (i.e. swim, spa or sauna, spray tan, wear contacts or sweat).
- Be gentle with your lashes. Do not excessively rub your eyes or pull on lashes. Avoid touching your lashes. The natural oils from your hands will break down the adhesive bond.
- Only use specially formulated OutLashe mascaras and cleansers for your extensions. Do not use oil-based products or waterproof mascaras as this will cause premature shedding of your extensions. Use mascara sparingly and never apply from base to tip. Gently remove mascara with OutLashe cleansers. Do not use cotton products such as cotton balls or Q-tips.
- To preserve the look of your extensions and extend their life, comb through each morning and apply OutLashe coating sealant daily.
- We recommend a re-lash appointment every two to four weeks to maintain the look of your initial application.
