**GASOLINE AND OIL INSPECTION
AFFIDAVIT AND INSPECTION FEE REPORT**

Sections 525.01, 525.09, F.S.
Rule 5F-2.003, F.A.C.

The applicant intends to sell or offer for sale petroleum fuel in the State of Florida. The applicant certifies that all petroleum fuel sold, offered or exposed for sale within this state by the applicant conforms to the standards prescribed by Department rule.

Section 525.09 requires that a one-eighth cent per gallon inspection fee on all gasoline, kerosene (except when used as aviation turbine fuel), and fuel oil #1 sold within this state be paid to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Before the applicant sells, offers or exposes for sale any petroleum fuel within this state, the applicant must list all terminal suppliers and importers of the petroleum fuel to be sold and establish responsibility for payment of the inspection fee.

The applicant is a Manufacturer Terminal Supplier Wholesaler Importer

The following manufacturers supply petroleum fuel to be sold by the applicant. By marking the box adjacent to the manufacturer company name and address, the applicant indicates that entity will be responsible for paying the inspection fee.

A "manufacturer" is any company or business entity producing petroleum fuel.

A "Terminal supplier" is any position holder that has been licensed by the Department of Revenue as a terminal supplier, that has met the requirements of ss. [206.05](#) and [206.90](#), and that is registered under the Internal Revenue Code (26 USC 4101) for transactions involving the bulk storage and transfer of taxable motor or diesel fuels.

A "Wholesaler" is any person who holds a valid wholesaler of taxable fuel license issued by the Florida Department of Revenue as a wholesaler as defined in s. 206.01(4), Florida Statutes.

An "Importer" is any person that has met the requirements of s. [206.051](#) and is licensed by the Department of Revenue to import motor fuel or diesel fuel upon which no pre-collection of tax has occurred, other than through bulk transfer, into this state by common carrier or company-owned trucks.
