## Are you eligible?

An owner, lessee, or trust beneficiary who is:

- Currently serving.
- Veteran.
- Student or alumnus of a military academy.


## Vehicles that qualify

Military plates are available for:

- An automobile.
- A motor home (annual registration only).
- A private truck, dual-purpose motor home or dual-purpose farm truck that has a gross weight of 8,000 pounds or less.
- A farm truck that has a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less.
Please note: NO special parking privileges are provided with Military plates.


## Things you should know

When you request Military plates, you pay:

- A \$15 issuance fee or the annual \$15 personalized plate fee.
- An annual registration fee, if your current plates expire within three months.
WisDOT will transfer funds from the issuance fee to the WI Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Trust Fund. This fee may be tax deductible for certain tax filers; consult your tax advisor.
To legally operate your vehicle, you must display license plates within two business days of purchase. If you do not have current plates, apply to a DMV Customer Service Center or an agent authorized by WisDOT to obtain a temporary plate while your plate application is processed. An agent may charge a plate and/or service fee.

## Personalized plate information

Personalizing your Military license plates is optional.

- A $\$ 15$ personalized plate fee is required each year in addition to the annual registration fee.
- No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after the plate has been ordered, or if the application is unclear or incorrectly completed.
- WisDOT may refuse to issue or may recall after issuance, a request that may be offensive to good taste or decency, is misleading, or conflicts with any other license plate.
- After the Certificate of Registration is issued, allow 4-6 weeks for the manufacturing and mailing process before the plates arrive.

## Release of nonexempt information

## How to apply

1. To order non-personalized Military plates, mark first option and go to step 5 below.
2. To order personalized Military plates, choose 1-6 characters. If you choose 6 characters, no spaces are allowed.


If you choose 5 characters, you may request up to 2 spaces between any of the characters. Indicate this request with diagonal lines as shown here.

3. Use capital letters or numbers. The letter $O$ and the number zero are the same. The following are not available: small letters, symbols, signs, hyphens, apostrophes, etc. Carefully distinguish between: letters $\mathbf{L}$ or $\mathbf{I}$ and number 1, letter $\mathbf{S}$ and number $\mathbf{5}$, letter $\mathbf{G}$ and number $\mathbf{6}$, letter $\mathbf{Z}$ and number 2, letter $\mathbf{B}$ and number $\mathbf{8}$, letters $\mathbf{U}$ and $\mathbf{V}$.
4. Provide a meaning for your request,
i.e., what does this represent?
5. If the vehicle you wish to register with Military plates is already titled in your name, send:
" A copy of your Certificate of Registration or complete the vehicle description on the application.
» \$15 issuance or personalized plate fee, plus the annual registration fee if the current plates expire within the next three months.
6. If the vehicle is not titled in your name, send:
" The title assigned to you.
» A completed title application: MV1 (private sale) or MV11 (dealer sale).
" All required fees, including annual registration fee.
" Additional \$15 issuance or personalized plate fee.
7. Send this application with signed Proof of Eligibility or photocopy of eligibility documentation.
