- 1) A separate application must be completed for each proposed event. The application must be typed or printed legibly in ink. Applications that are illegible will not be processed.
- 2) All required information must be accurately completed.
- 3) The club or event chairperson must sign the application and type / print their full name in the space provided in Section C.
- 4) A separate application must be submitted for each regatta or marine event. However, if a proposed regatta continues for several consecutive days, then it is only necessary to complete one application.
- 5) Applications must be submitted **fifteen days** prior to the date of the proposed event.
- 6) Regatta applications for boat races, parades, exhibitions, or other significant marine events that will limit or obstruct the use of a public waterway must be submitted **sixty days** prior to the event. Refer to Section B of this application for specific instructions.
