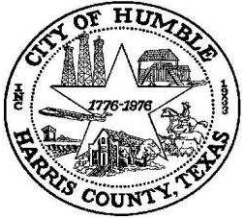

City of Humble Code of Ordinance” ALARM SYSTEMS

Sec. 4-75. Charge for the city response to alarm.

(A) Each alarm user in the city will be allowed the following number of false alarms in a twelve-month period during the calendar year (January 1 through December 31) without charge to the alarm user:

- (1) Five (5) false fire alarms.
- (2) Five (5) false burglar alarms.
- (3) Five (5) false hold-up alarms.

(B) Charges for false alarms shall be as follows:

(1) Burglar alarms (**over the five-alarm limit**):

- (a) 1 to 5 alarms, per alarm \$ 50.00
- (b) 6 to 10 alarms, per alarm 75.00
- (c) more than 10 alarms, per alarm 100.00

(2) Hold-up alarms (**over the five-alarm limit**):

- (a) 1 to 5 alarms, per alarm \$ 75.00
- (b) 6 alarms and above, per alarm 150.00

(3) Fire alarms (**over the five-alarm limit, residential**):

- (a) 1 to 5 alarms, per alarm \$ 50.00
- (b) 6 to 10 alarms, per alarm 75.00
- (c) more than 10 alarms, per alarm 100.00

(4) Fire alarms (**over the five-alarm limit, commercial**):

- (a) 1 to 5 alarms, per alarm \$ 100.00
- (b) 6 to 10 alarms, per alarm 150.00
- (c) more than 10 alarms, per alarm 200.00

(C) The city will not monitor any alarm whose physical location is not within the corporate limits of the city.

(D) The burden of proof that the activation of the alarm system was not a false alarm shall rest with the alarm user.
