The convention calls for frequency lists to show four digits after the decimal place, followed by either an "N" or a "W", depending on whether the frequency is narrow or wide band. Mode refers to either "A" or "D" indicating analog or digital (e.g. Project 25/D-STAR) or "M" indicating mixed mode. All channels are shown as if programmed in a control station, mobile or portable radio. **Repeater and base stations must be programmed with the Rx and Tx reversed.**
