



Payment Voucher and Instructions for Form IT-370 Filed Online Automatic Extension of Time to File for Individuals

Who must use this form

You must submit this voucher with your payment if you file a balance due extension online using Form IT-370, Application for Automatic Extension of Time to File. If you pay by credit card, you do not file this form.

Separate extension requests must be submitted for a husband and wife who file separate returns.

When to file

You must pay the amount you owe on or before April 15, 2005, to avoid interest and penalty. For fiscal year filers, the filing deadline is the 15th day of the fourth month following the close of your tax year.

Mailing instructions

Enclose a check or money order payable to New York State Income Tax for the full amount you owe and write your social security number and 2004 Income Tax on it.

Private delivery services — If you choose, you may use a private delivery service, instead of the U.S. Postal Service, to file your return and pay tax. However, if, at a later date, you need to establish the date you filed your return or paid your tax, you cannot use the date recorded by a private delivery service unless you used a delivery service that has been designated by the U.S. Secretary of the Treasury or the Commissioner of Taxation and Finance.

Privacy notification

The Commissioner of Taxation and Finance may collect and maintain personal information pursuant to the New York State Tax Law, including but not limited to, sections 171, 171-a, 287, 308, 429, 475, 505, 697, 1096, 1142, and 1415 of that Law; and may require disclosure of social security numbers pursuant to 42 USC 405(c)(2)(C)(i).

This information will be used to determine and administer tax liabilities and, when authorized by law, for certain tax offset and exchange of tax information programs as well as for any other lawful purpose.

Information concerning quarterly wages paid to employees is provided to certain state agencies for purposes of fraud prevention, support enforcement, evaluation of the effectiveness of certain employment and training programs and other purposes authorized by law.

Failure to provide the required information may subject you to civil or criminal penalties, or both, under the Tax Law.

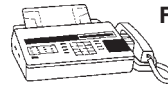
