PART I – CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE					
<p>Japanese law requires pets entering Japan to be quarantined up to 180 days. Pets belonging to U.S. Forces personnel may be placed in a “Working Quarantine” in the custody of the owner under the supervision of the U. S. Forces veterinary service for <u>on-post/base housing, providing all paper work has been properly completed</u>. Quarantine length depends on proper identification, rabies vaccine history, Fluorescent Antibody Viral Neutralization Test (FAVN) results, date of FAVN testing, and appropriately prepared and verified documents. You must: 1) keep your pet in travel carrier until arrival at military installation; 2) report to the U. S. Forces veterinary clinic within 72 hours, or the first clinic day following arrival of the animal to Japan; 3) present your animal to the U. S. Forces veterinary clinic within 72 hours of completion of the quarantine requirement.</p> <p>In accordance with the above, I request the pet(s) described below be placed in quarantine in my custody under the supervision of the U. S. Forces veterinary service. I will present my pet(s) to the U.S. Forces veterinary clinic as prescribed and immediately notify vet clinic if my pet exhibits unusual behavior, becomes ill or dies. I will keep my pet(s) within my household on U. S. Installation at all times during the quarantine period. PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT
