REQUEST FOR FORM 1099-G

Form 1099-G reports the total taxable unemployment compensation you received for the calendar year. If you do not know the "total unemployment compensation", it can be skipped. If you want to request <u>corrections</u> to Form 1099-G for either the current or prior year, complete <u>both</u> the "current information" and "correct information" boxes below **making sure that the box entitled 'taxable year' is completed.** You can request a 1099-G for calendar years 2013-2019.

If you have paid restitution for improperly paid unemployment benefits or court-ordered deductions, those monies are still included in the total unemployment compensation. Those amounts cannot be removed from total compensation reported. Contact the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to get specific instructions on how those amounts affect your taxes and how to report them.
