DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of a mechanic's or storage lien, the following definitions apply:

Trade in Value -- the vehicle value as determined by the NADA OFFICIAL USED CAR GUIDE.

Notice of Intent to Sell Virginia record found -- The mechanic or lienholder must arrange for the vehicle to be sold at a public auction, and at least 10 days prior to the public auction:

- notify the owner and lienholder, if any, by certified mail return receipt, of the date, time and place of the auction, and
- advertise the date, time, place and terms of the auction in at least one public place (see definition below).

Note: If the MSL Transcript indicates that the vehicle owner is on active military duty or service, you must obtain a court order granting the enforcement of the lien as required under the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, 50 U.S.C. App §535. DMV will begin collecting this information, effective July 1, 2008, on all title and registration applications; therefore the active military duty status will not be available for all customers. As a result, the MSL applicant will be responsible for obtaining the active military duty status from other sources.

Notice of Intent to Sell, No Virginia or non-Virginia record found or the owner's address is unknown -- The mechanic or storage lienholder must arrange for the vehicle to be sold at public auction, and at least 10 days prior to the public auction, advertise the date, time, place and terms of the auction in three different public places (see definition below).

Public Place -- premises owned by the Commonwealth of Virginia or a political subdivision thereof, or an agency of either which is open to the public and permits such postings.

Independent Appraiser - Someone who provides the MSL applicant with an estimated trade-in value appraisal and does not gain income or have personal or business related interest in the ownership or sale of the vehicle.

INSTRUCTIONS

To obtain a Virginia title or Non-Repairable Certificate for the vehicle, follow these instructions according to the vehicle's value.

\$3,001 to \$12,500	<p>The mechanic or storage lienholder must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request DMV to search title records available for the vehicle owner and lienholder, if any; and • Make notice of the intent to sell the vehicle (as described above). <p>The purchaser (after the auction) must present to DMV all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The results of DMV's record search and a completed Mechanic's or Storage Lien Application (VSA 41, pages 1 & 3); • A completed Application for Certificate of Title and Registration (VSA 17A) with applicable fees or a completed Application for Non-Repairable Certificate (VSA 57); • A bill of sale from the mechanic or storage lienholder holding the auction; • A copy of the public auction notice and location of posting; • A copy of the original repair order; and • The return receipt for the certified mail, if delivered, or the certified letter (unopened) with the return receipt attached, if not delivered. The return receipt can be an electronic copy from the U.S. Postal Service.
